REQUIRED WORK DOCUMENTS

All youth that participate in Step Up need to prove their age, identity and eligibility to work in the United States. If you are unable to prove **ALL** of these, you will **NOT** be able to work in your Step Up internship.

You must show all of the following at your Virtual Placement Appointment

- Your Social Security Card
- Proof of how old you are
- Photo identification
- Proof of U.S. Citizenship or eligibility to work in the U.S.

Follow the chart below for tips on finding these identification documents. Due to COVID-19 most Government agencies are closed. Below are suggestions of documentation that can be used at your virtual placement appointment.

EVERYONE must show a Social Security Card

- If you don't have a Social Security Card or need a replacement, find out how to get a replacement card at
 - http://www.ssa.gov/ssnumber
- It can take several weeks to get a Social Security Card, so begin the process NOW.
- Apply for a copy on a US government website. DO NOT use a third party site.

EVERYONE must to show a document to prove your age. This may include:

- Birth Certificate
- U.S. Passport
- Permanent Resident Card
- State Issued Identification Card
- State Issued Driver's License
- Official School Identification Card with Printed Birthdate

EVERYONE must show document with a photo to prove your identity. This may include:

- U.S. Passport or U.S. Passport Card
- Permanent Resident Card
- State Issued Identification Card
- State Issued Driver's License
- Official School Identification Card

IF YOU ARE NOT A U.S. CITIZEN, you will need a document to prove you are eligible to work in the United States. You will need to show ONE of the following IN ADDITION TO other documents:

- Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card (I-551)
- Temporary Resident Card (I-688)
- Employment Authorization Document (I-766, I-688B, or I-688A)
- Foreign Passport with temporary I-551 stamp
